A Study on the Usage of Herbal Anti Acne Cream among the Different Youths of Sikkim.

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ABSTRACT

One of the most prevalent chronic inflammatory diseases of the pilosebaceous follicles acne caused by androgen-induced sebum hyperplasia, follicular keratinization, hormonal imbalance, immunological hypersensitivity, and bacterial colonization that mainly occurs in adolescents and young adults. Topical, systemic, hormonal, herbal, and combination therapies are frequently employed to treat acne. One of the most preferred treatments adopted by youngsters for acne is herbal remedies can be effective and safe. A variety range of products is available in the market today that is attracting youngsters for its effective use and without any adverse effects. Most of these products are quite affordable and are available with the required quantity of pack size. Youngsters especially in the hilly region have different interests and try to identify the right way to treat acne and look a better version of them while at the same time they also focus on their budget. This study focuses on the usage of different brands of herbal anti-acne cream by young people in Sikkim acne vulgarism. treat This framework provides an excellent description o f the different brands available in the Himalayan and the interests of different individuals who aspire to be fit, healthy and attractive.

I. INTRODUCTION

The human body's skin is the most exposed component. The constant exposure of human skin to ultraviolet (UV) radiation, pollution, dust, and chemicals, among other things, causes a variety of skin problems. Acne, pimples,

hyperpigmentation, and sunburn are few examples. The most common follicular skin disorder is acne vulgaris (acne). Mostly affects the face's pilosebaceous follicular unit the head, neck, and trunk. Acne is one of the most common chronic inflammatory disease^[1] of the pilosebaceous follicles involving androgen-induced sebaceous hyperplasia, follicular keratinization, hormonal imbalance, immune hypersensitivity, and bacterial colonization. Particularly for teenagers and adolescents, acne vulgaris is a concerning problem. Global statistics show that over 85% of people will experience this skin condition between the ages of 12 and 25. At ages 23 and 34, nearly 8% of individuals will experience acne vulgaris, and only 3% of adults will experience it between the ages of 35 and 44. [3] The course of acne treatment is determined by its severity. Patients with severe acne, characterized by widely dispersed pustules and papules, are typically offered oral and topical treatments. [4] Over \$1 billion is reportedly spent annually in the US on acne-related medical visits and treatments, according to a 2001 survey. It should be noted that these treatments are only means of controlling the follicular disease rather than a cure. [5]

Seborrhea (excess grease), inflammatory lesions (papules and pustules), non-inflammatory lesions (open and closed comedones), and varying degrees of scarring from cyst formation are among the clinical symptoms of acne. Acne can be divided into two categories based on the type of lesion: inflammatory acne (mild, scarring, and nodular acne) and non-inflammatory acne (only comedonal acne). Acne can be divided into three categories based on severity: mild, moderate, and severe. Open and closed comedones (<20), inflammatory lesions (<15), and a total of lesions not more than 30 are considered to be symptoms of mild acne.

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Similar to mild acne, moderate acne is characterized by the presence of comedones (20–100), inflammatory lesions (15–50), and total lesions (30–125). Extensive lesions, such as nodules and cysts along with scarring (>5), total comedone count (>100), total inflammatory count (>50), and the total number of lesions greater than 125, are indicative of severe acne. Low stomach acid is a prevalent finding in acne patients, according to several research. This shows that treating acne vulgaris may benefit greatly from the traditional usage of bitter herbs, which work by promoting digestive processes, particularly the generation of acid. Herbs that include antibacterial, anti-inflammatory, anticomedogenic, and, occasionally, hormonebalancing properties are also effective in treating acne. [7] Evaluation and improvement of a population's teenage health is a crucial step toward achieving a healthier adult population. Acne can alter one's appearance, but it can also have harmful consequences, and effects on adolescent's psychological well-being. Unfortunately, acne patients may suffer for years before being referred to a specialist or receiving appropriate treatment and the majority of them do not seek treatment at all. For acne management, seek medical guidance as a result, there is a need for population-based studies in which the effect can be measured. The effects of acne on mental health and perceptions of reliable measures were used to investigate the situation. Such inquiries attract the adolescents' attention to the topic. Even this could be helpful as a first step toward seeking treatment for the treatment of acne. Acne treatment admissions can be expensive if adolescents learn more about it, their interest will be piqued. There is a considerable body of knowledge in the fields of basic science and clinical medicine.^[8]

Depending on the kind of acne and its accompanying symptoms, conventional topical treatments for AV mostly involve antibacterial agents, reducing sebum secretion, boosting cellular turnover, anti-inflammatory agents, and in situations of severe AV, oral antibiotics^[9], retinoids^[10], and hormone therapy^[11]. However, using traditional treatments can result in treatment costs that are too high, severe side effects, and resistance to antibacterial drugs. Herbal remedies, on the other hand, have been used for decades to treat AV with fewer adverse effects and greater patient compliance. Their primary modes of action stem from their antimicrobial, anti-inflammatory, and anti-erythematous properties. Additionally, certain plant-based substances demonstrated anti-

inflammatory^[12] and antioxidant properties.^[13,14] The four primary pathophysiological elements that contribute to the development of acne are sebaceous hyperplasia and hyperproduction; sebaceous duct hyperkeratinization; bacterial colonization and proliferation, mostly by Cutibacterium acnes; and inflammatory response. ^[15]

Symptoms of Acne

Inflammatory acne - Papules, Pustules and Nodules Non- Inflammatory acne - Blackheads and Whiteheads

Social Symptoms - Anxiety and depression, Loss of self-confidence, and may withdraw from society.

Causes of Acne

- 1. Hormonal Stimulation Hormones play an important role in causing acne. An increase in hormones such as androgen in males and females during puberty causes the enlargement of sebaceous glands and makes more sebum that results in the formation of acne. The underlying reason could possibly be excessive testosterone or polycystic ovarian syndrome (PCOS).
- 2. Diet The intake of food plays a major role in the health of an individual. The appearance of acne usually deteriorates by consuming food rich in carbohydrates and fats. If you eat a lot of non-nutritious meals like takeout, chocolate, and sweets, your body isn't obtaining enough nutrients. This type of diet might also aggravate a skin type that is already temperamental.
- 3. Medication- Intake of medicine causes various side-effects, medication containing corticosteroids, lithium, or testosterone can result in the formation of acne.
- 4. Stress Stress usually doesn't cause acne, but research has shown that stress triggers hormonal changes that will result in the worsening of the acne. Stress is so detrimental to the body in every aspect that it is thought that it can trigger the release of cortisol. This is a hormone that causes your body to create extra oil, clogging pores and aggravating acne. [17]

Herbal treatment of acne

Herbal cosmetics are made with a base consisting of a variety of approved cosmetic ingredients, over which one or more herbal compounds are added to achieve specific cosmetic effects.^[18] Treatment for the acne is carried out by using herbal plant extracts from the ancient period. Herbal remedies usually have lower side effects



than the synthetic product. Herbal plants possess antibacterial ^[19], anti-inflammatory and antiseptic properties ^[20]. These properties of herbal remedies help in reducing acne-causing bacteria, inflammation and heal blemishes. ^[21] Herbal drugs are better than synthetic products because they possess less toxicity and provide better therapeutic action. ^[22]

II. METHODOLOGY

The study was conducted through a survey of youths of Sikkim, who were suffering from acne. We also visited various pharmacy stores in Sikkim to gather information about the availability of herbal anti-acne cream. The information about the acne-like product they have been using, and the side effects of the product were surveyed among the youth of Sikkim. This method was found to be effective.

The questionnaire consists of the following parts:

- 1. Which are the herbal anti-acne creams you usually use?
- 2. Whether they were effective?
- 3. For how long have you using the herbal anti-acne cream?
- 4. What difference do you find between the herbal anti-acne creams from the synthetic cream?
- 5. Do you prefer herbal anti-acne cream over synthetic cream? Why?
- 6. Did you use this cream you used for the first time? If No, what was the product you used?
- 7. What are the side effects have you faced while using herbal anti-acne cream?
- 8. Are they cost-effective than synthetic products?
- 9. Are they easily available?
- 10. What is the goodness of the herbal anti-acne cream you use?
- 11. Are you satisfied with the pack size?

The survey was conducted in two phases. In phase I, the survey was started by focusing on school and college students of Sikkim, then on random youths. The survey was done among 179 individuals of Sikkim of different districts by a simple explanation of the study was followed by the questionnaire. It was done in Pharmacy stores of different districts of Sikkim covering important cities namely Gangtok, Namchi, Geyzing, Mangan, Jorthang, Soreng, and Singtam to gather information about the availability of herbal antiacne cream, the most used herbal anti-acne product by youth, etc. In Government Pharmacy College,

Sajong a survey was conducted among 59 students who were using herbal anti-acne cream for acne. The students were having acne from mild to severe. Out of 59 participants, 55 were girls and 4 were boys. The remaining 120 surveys were conducted among students of different colleges and random youths.

In phase II, the survey was focused on students of different schools and colleges in remote areas of different districts of Sikkim. The survey was conducted among 204 individual students of Sikkim. Similarly, like phase I, the survey was conducted with a simple explanation about the study followed by the questionnaire. Out of 204 students, 181 students were girls and 25 were boys. In total 383 surveys were conducted among students of different colleges in Sikkim followed by random youths. Out of which 331 participants were girls and 52 were boys.

III. FINDING AND DISCUSSION

A total of 383 surveys were conducted out of which 331 were girls and 52 were boys between the age of 19 to 35. The result data showed more prevalent and severe in girls than boys, the major factors implicated among causes of acne were food, bad skin hygiene, and hormones in decreasing frequency. Several benefits of using herbal antiacne cream were recorded during the survey-

- 1. It has less side effects,
- 2. Suitable for all skin types,
- 3. It is obtained from natural ingredients,
- 4. It is inexpensive
- 5. It has a good soothing effect and provides the desired results.

The top five herbal anti-acne creams used by the youth of Sikkim were as follows-

- 1. Himalaya acne-n-pimple cream
- 2. Biotique spot-correcting anti-acne cream
- 3. Himalaya clarina anti-acne cream
- 4. Khadi Natural Anti-acne cream
- 5. Vicco turmeric skin cream for anti-acne

Around 70% of the participants in the survey were satisfied with the pack size remaining 30% were unsatisfied with the pack size of the herbal anti-acne cream. From the survey, it was found that for at least 9 months the participants were using the herbal anti-acne cream to get the desired results.

Herbal anti-acne cream prescribed by the doctor-OMNI herbal anti-acne cream, Himalaya pimple clear cream, and Ayurvedic active acne-free




Figure 1: Percentage Availability of Herbal Anti-Acne Cream in Different Locations of Sikkim

IV. SUMMARY AND CONCLUSIONS

Acne vulgaris, also known as acne, is a persistent skin disorder caused by excessive sebaceous gland production in the follicle. This illness has a negative impact on self-esteem. When incorrect sebaceous therapies for acne therapy are used, the pathological aspect of acne begins. Many negative effects are induced by chemical components in cosmetics, which are regularly utilized to irritate the skin and cause bacterial resistance issues. The main elements contributing to the development of acne lesions are increased sebum production, keratinocyte sloughing, bacterial growth and inflammation.

As it is most likely seen in pre-teens and teenagers. It has been stated that there is a rising trend towards herbal medicine as the demand has increased. To clinch the scenario, herbal anti-acne cream for acne fits in the best. The properties of herbal anti-acne cream include anti-inflammatory, anti-bacterial, and anti-androgenic properties.

The survey gathered 383 responses from the different districts of Sikkim, with 85 percent of the respondents being girls and 15 percent being boys. And of the 85 percent of girls, 40% were adults and 45% were young respondents. Between those, 85% of females and 40% of males were found with acne and had symptoms such as itching, redness, painful lumps, tender bumps, and pimples. The top 5 herbal anti acne-creams used by the youth of Sikkim were

- 1. Himalaya acne-n- pimple cream
- 2. Biotique spot-correcting anti-acne cream
- 3. Himalaya clarina anti acne cream
- 4. Vicco turmeric skin cream for anti-acne
- 5. Khadi acne pimple cream

Findings showed that most of the herbal anti-acne cream users were satisfied with the pack size, price, and the result it gave. And most of the users were using without any recommendation by the doctor and few of them were using as per the prescription. The herbal anti-acne creams were found to be cost effective with the price ranges from Rs 45 to Rs 500. It also has the fewer side effects on long-term use.

Common side effects faced by the users while using the herbal anti-acne cream.

- Itching
- burning sensation
- redness
- dryness
- dizziness.
- peeling of skin and

Nausea

Many of the participants had acne problems due to the lifestyle they had, the change in hormonal balance and the products they were using not according to their skin type.

BENEFITS OF HERBAL ANTI-ACNE CREAM
